Sten H. Vermund, MD, PhD is a pediatrician and infectious disease epidemiologist, Amos Christie Chair in Global Health, and director of the Institute for Global Health at Vanderbilt University School of Medicine. He is PI for the following current projects: Care/treatment of HIV/AIDS in Mozambique and Nigeria (PEPFAR); HIV Prevention Trials Network Coordinating and Operations Center; Vanderbilt-UAB AIDS International Training Research Program; Cervical Cancer Screening in HIV-Infected Women in India; Measuring HIV incidence in China; the Vanderbilt-Meharry Framework Program in Global Health; and the Fogarty International Clinical Research Scholars Support Center. Dr. Vermund founded both the UAB Centre for Infectious Disease Research in Zambia in 2000 and Friends in Global Health, LLC, in 2006, a non-governmental organization in Mozambique affiliated with Vanderbilt.
